

# **Privacy and Data Protection**

When it comes to your personal data you are in control - and we are just as transparent. We want to make sure that you understand why we ask you for some personal data, what we do with that information, and the rights and choices you have over how we use your data.

This Privacy Notice explains how we process your data. If you have any further questions about Show Your Bump and your personal data, please contact our Data Controller at info@showyourbump.co.uk By booking your ultrasound scan with Show Your Bump you consent to the collection, use and transfer of your information under the terms of this policy.

### 1. The Data Controller

# 2. Our legal basis for collecting and processing your data

#### **Contractual basis**

When you book our services, instructing us to carry out your ultrasound scan, you are agreeing to be bound by this Privacy Notice which is part of the T&C and together form the basis of our contractual relationship with you. Therefore, we may collect, hold and process your personal data on the basis that you have accepted our contractual terms by agreeing to this Privacy Notice and the T&Cs.

### Consent

We collect, hold and process your personal data on the basis that you give us consent when you book your ultrasound scan with us and accept this Privacy Notice. In other words, we set out what we are going to do with your data in this Privacy Notice.

We will send a copy of this privacy notice to you by email if required and optional when we send you our consent form and directions.



We ask you to read this Privacy Notice to ensure you are happy with the way that Show Your Bump will process your data.

We ask you to sign to confirm that you agree with our Privacy Notice when you sign your consent form on the day of your scan.

You remain in control of the personal data you share with Show Your Bump. You can tell us your preferences at any time, by choosing whether you want to give consent to your data being processed for specific types of communication and / or communication channels. You can cancel your scan at any time and your details and information will be deleted.

### **Legitimate interest**

We may collect, hold and process your personal data on the basis of legitimate interest where it is necessary in order for us to fulfil our needs as a business and to be able to provide you with our services, in the following ways:

- to send you information about Show Your Bump.
- to refer you to your medical provider, in cases where an anomaly is found
- to keep records as required by law,
- we may also send you marketing emails, from ourselves, of offers/discounts we are offering that you
  may be interested in.
- to send you information

**NOTE:** if you do not want to continue to receive these types of emails - notifications - you can opt-out at any time by sending an email to the following email address info@showyourbump.co.uk

#### **Vital interest**

We may use your personal information to contact you if we reasonably believe that there is any urgent safety need that we need to communicate to you because the processing of your personal data will prevent or reduce any potential harm to you. This type of notification is in your vital interest.

#### **Legal Obligation**

We may use and process your personal data to comply with our legal obligations such as HMRC requirements, if the Police requests it to identify you as an individual if you contact us, or to verify the accuracy of your data.

#### 3. The data we collect



In order to operate Show Your Bump, we ask you to share some basic personal information with us when you book your scan:

- Your name and contact details
- Your title, first name and last name so that we can address you correctly
- Your mobile number so that we can contact you
- Your date of birth only needed if we have to refer you to your medical provider
- Your views and opinions

From time to time we may carry out market research or surveys. Any answers to market research surveys that you give will be anonymised and amalgamated together with other Show Your Bump clients. Participation in research is entirely voluntary.

#### 4. Automatic collection of data

Most website owners track visitors to their website using 'cookies'. They also track other information on web visitors such as the IP address of computers in order to understand where web traffic come from, and where it goes on their site, device ID, and location information. Show Your Bump also uses these technologies on its website.

### 5. How we use your information

We may use the data we hold in the following ways:

To operate Show Your Bump, such as providing you with our services so you can benefit from it.

- Provide you with information about Show Your Bumps products which you may be interested in:
- To contact you where necessary concerning your booking, e.g. in response to a query.
- To contact you occasionally for your views on how Show Your Bump operates and ways to improve the service.
- To notify you occasionally about important changes or developments to Show Your Bump or updates to our Privacy Notice.

#### Direct marketing

In these cases, you have the right to opt in or opt out of certain uses of your personal information and the type of information that you will be receiving from us, as set out in this Privacy Notice.

You can choose to receive news, offers, promotions and competitions that enhance the experience of being a Show Your Bump customer:



- To be informed about other products, services and offers which may be of interest to you.
- To enter you into promotional prize draws, competitions or other promotional activities or prize giveaways we think may be of interest to you.

We also collect this information to understand you and your shopping habits, so that we can send you relevant and timely offers and communications:

To improve and develop our business through the better understanding of Show Your Bumps clients:

• We may use and analyse the information we collect so that we can manage Show Your Bump and administer, support, improve and develop our business.

# **Anonymous information that we collect**

We may also use and share aggregate information relating to groups of customers, without identifying individuals, to learn more about customer behaviour and find ways of enhancing our service. For example, we might look at the aggregated behaviour of Show Your Bumps clients to understand how bookings vary.

### 6. Disclosing your data to other companies or organizations

We share your details with your medical provider and the CQC only when its necessary, in order to do our job, and in your best interests.

We would disclose your personal data in the unusual circumstances of being legally obliged to do so e.g. as part of a police investigation.


We will not share your information with other third parties for different purposes without your prior consent.

We do not sell your personal information to third parties.

In the unlikely event that our business was sold we would disclose your information to the buyer.

If this business is sold or integrated with another business your details may be disclosed to our advisers and any prospective purchasers and their advisers and will be passed on to the new owners of the business

In addition to the specific disclosures of Personal Data set out in this Privacy Notice, we may disclose your Personal Data where such disclosure is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which we are subject, or to protect your vital interests or the vital interests of another natural person. We may also disclose your Personal Data where such disclosure is necessary for the establishment,



exercise or defence of legal claims, whether in court proceedings or in an administrative or out-of-court procedure.

# 7. Your Rights and Choices

New data protection laws have come into force across Europe that give you more rights and choices about how your data is used. The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) strengthens your rights over how companies use your data. A summary of these rights is as follows:

- The right to insist that brands who hold your data are transparent about how they use your personal information, and fair in the way they process and use it.
- The right to access your personal information.
- The right to insist that companies correct any mistakes in the information they hold.
- The right to erase or delete your personal information in certain situations.
- The right to receive a copy of your personal data held by a company, in certain situations.
- The right to opt-out of direct marketing.
- The right to object to automated decision processes which significantly affect or disadvantage you, in certain circumstances.
- The right to object to continued processing of your personal information, in certain circumstances.
- The right to restrict the way that companies process your personal information, in certain circumstances.



Show Your Bump gives you control of your personal data held by us and the way that Show Your Bump uses your data. You can choose to update or amend your personal data at any time:

- Your booking includes your personal details (mentioned before), your preferences for the channels we use to communicate with you and your communications preferences (as stated below).
- You can update the details of your account, and your preferences, at any time. Simply contact show

  to cancel your booking at any time.

#### 8. Storage and Accuracy of Personal Information

Where we Store your Personal Information





The data that we collect from you is stored as securely as is reasonably possible. Consent forms have to be stored for 1 month after your visit to Show Your Bump and a stored in a secure, locked cupboard. The data on the consent form consists of your forename, surname, date of birth, baby's due date and the date and time of your appointment and email address. The electronic diary contains the following but not limited to, your forename, surname contact number. Your personal information is entered onto our computer booking system (when you book) and access to the booking system is password protected and access is restricted to only those that need to know. We recommend, that if you leave a comment in our feedback form, that you don't leave personal information that would identify you.

We will not process any of your personal data through third parties.

Show Your Bump will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that personal data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Notice and as permitted by data protection legislation.

By submitting your personal data, you agree to its, storing and processing as it is described above. We take all reasonable steps to ensure that your information is accurate, up-to-date, complete, relevant and not misleading.

### 9. Retention and Deletion of Personal Information

We will retain your information for one month to fulfil the purpose(s) for which it was collected and to comply with applicable laws and your consent.

### 10. What to do if you have a concern or complaint about our use of your personal data

We strive to act in accordance with all relevant data protection legislation, at all times.

### 12. Access to information (Subject Access Request)

You have the right to access the information we hold about you, and we will provide you with an initial copy free of charge.

Our website uses tools to make the service easier for you to use: to know more about how we use cookies.

### **Cookies**

A "cookie" is an element of data that a website can send to your browser, which may then store it on your system. It can then be used to provide you with tailored information. We may use the information to research and understand how customer habits are similar or different so that we can enhance your experience on our site. We do not match cookie data to any personal identification. # **Disabling Cookies**

If you do not wish to accept our Cookies you can decline Cookies and/or refuse access to previously stored information by using your web browser. The facilities within your web browser to allow you to do this will vary from browser to browser but they may be found in the "Privacy" or "Cookies" section of the "Properties" menu of your browser. If you require assistance in disabling Cookies you should refer to the "help" menu within your browser. Please note however, if cookies are disabled, you may not be able to use all of the interactive features of our website and it may limit the service we are able to provide to you via the website.

### Referrers



A "referrer" is the information passed along by a web browser that references the Web URL you linked from, and it is automatically gathered by our web server. This information is used by us to identify broad demographic trends that may be used to provide information tailored to your interests.

# **IP** address data

IP addresses are automatically gathered by our web server. Your IP address is a number that is used by computers on the network to identify your computer so that data (such as the web pages you request) can be sent to you. You will not be personally identified from this information. Your IP address may also be used to assist in the detection of fraud and we may pass this information to the Police. Environment variables we gather include time, type of web browser being used, the operating system/platform, and CPU speed. This information is used only for broad demographic information. This information is used by us in identifying broad demographic trends and may be used to provide information tailored to your interests.

# 14. Changes to our Privacy Notice

Any changes to our Privacy Notice in the future will be posted to the site and, where appropriate, through e-mail notification within 30 days in advance.
